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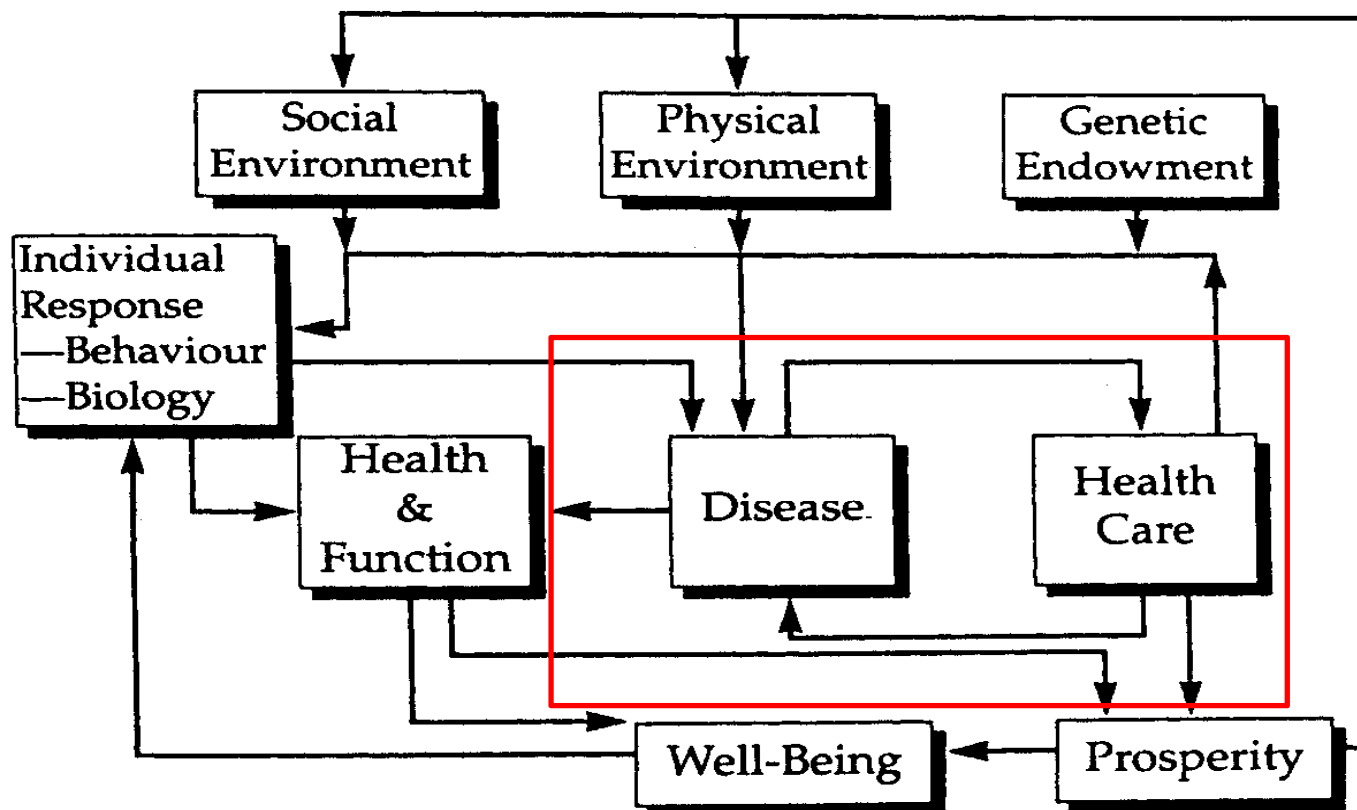

# Health Field Concept (Evens 1994)

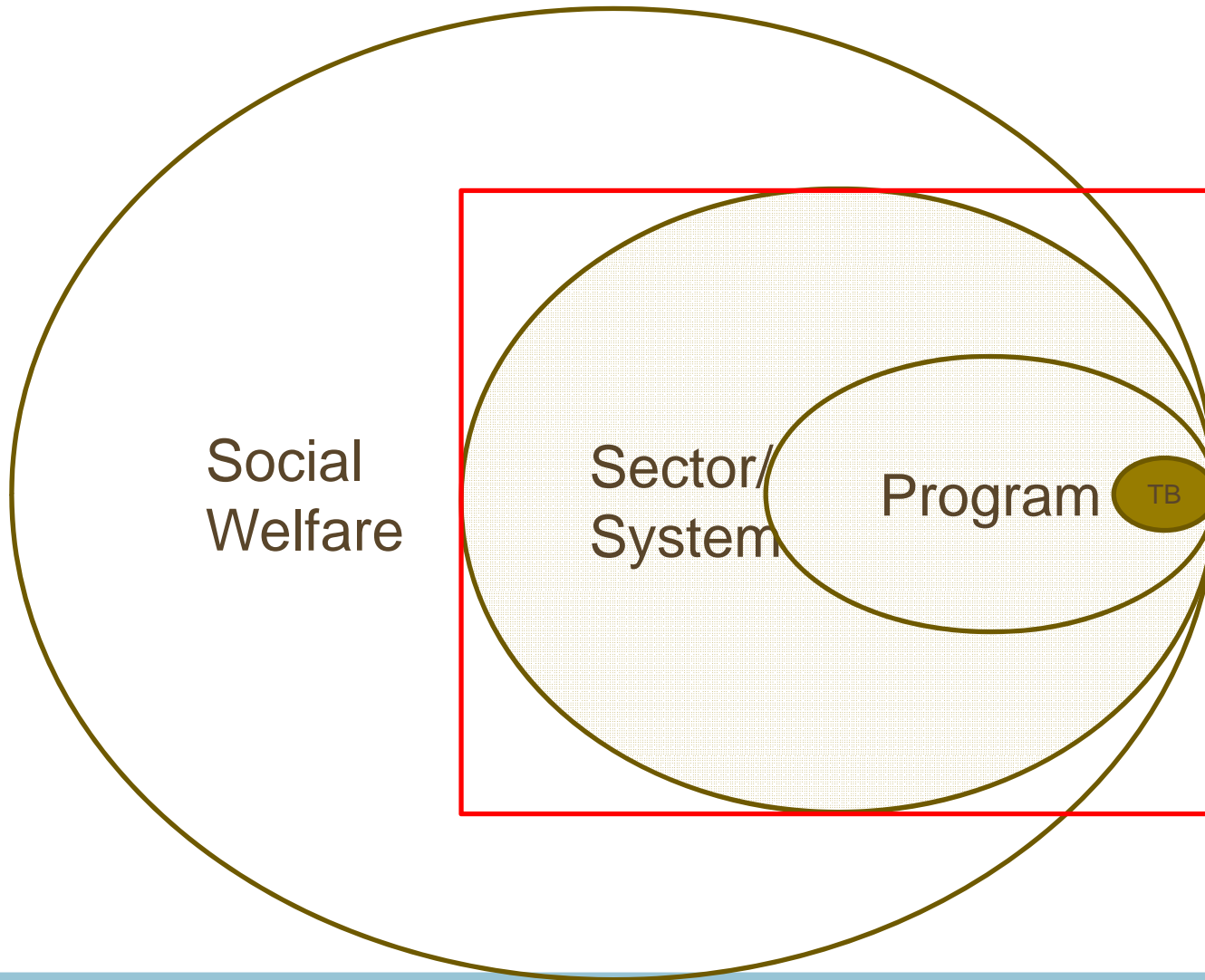

# How much health outcome improvement could be achieved by fully implementing what we know about prevention and clinical services (Bunker, JP, 1995)

- LE increases occurred early in last century has been attributed largely to non-medical factors
  - 1-1.5 years due to preventive, with 7-8 months potential
  - 3-4 years due to curative, with 1.5 years potential
- 5 years of partial or complete relief from the poor quality of life can be attributed to medical care
- The association of social factors with is well-known, but it is not known how they act

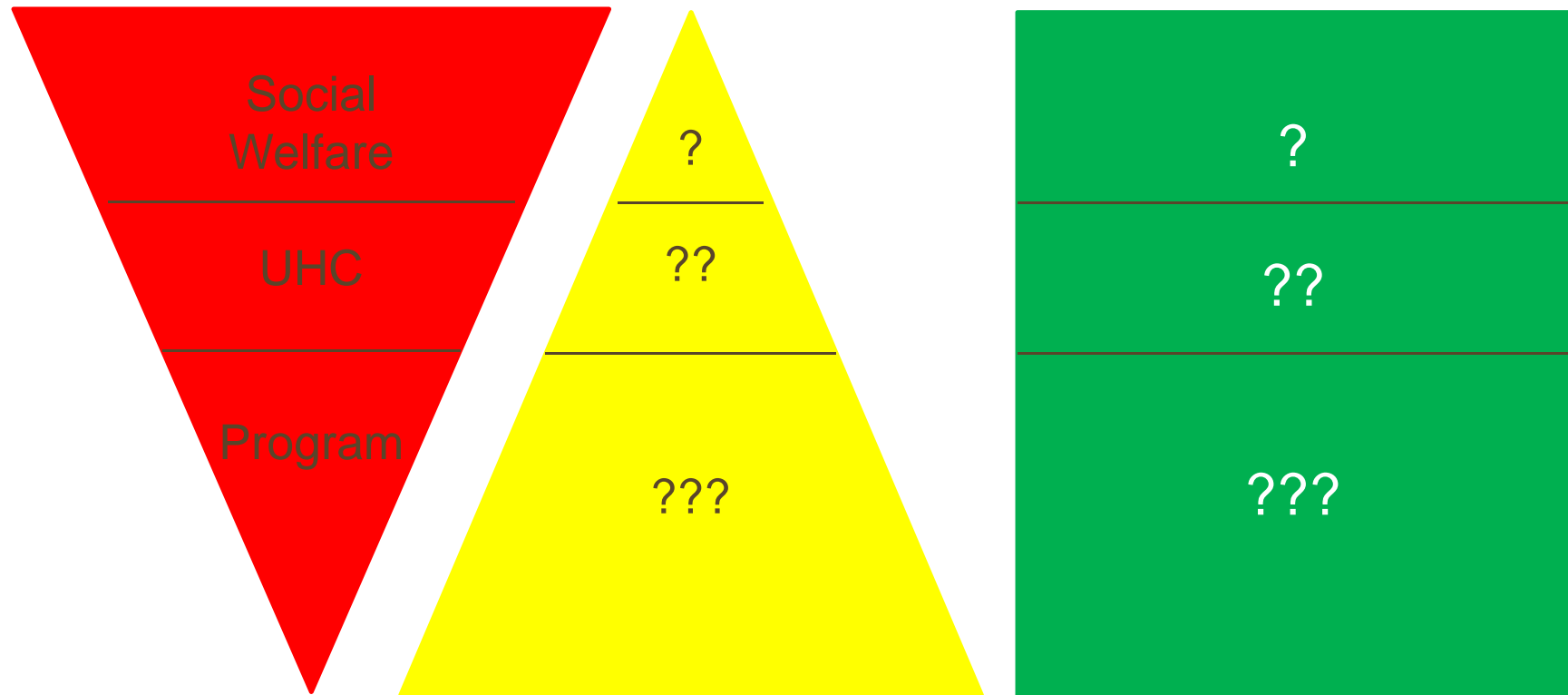
